## **ANNUAL REPORT FOR 2018**

#### Information for Parents:

#### Student Information:

Chrysalis Montessori School is an independent school catering for pre-Kindy to Year 6 students, with total enrolments of 140.

#### Student Attendance

Overall Chrysalis had an average student attendance rate of 93% for 2018.

#### Management of non-attendance

Parents of the school can use the school app 'e' absentee form, email or telephone the school of any absences of their child. Class teachers report any absences to the front office by 9:15am daily. The school admin follows up on any unexplained absence by contacting the Parent. The school has a late and early departure sign in and out system set up at the front office.

#### 2018 NAPLAN Results

In 2018, our year 3 and 5 students performed considerably higher than the Australian and Western Australian mean across most tests.

Due to the small amount of students sitting the tests at each year level, results may be significantly affected by the cohort composition. E.g. 1 student with significant learning difficulties may represent 25% of a year level cohort.
